IN VIRGINIA, state graded feeder cattle mostly 4.00 to 13.00 lower. Feeder cattle at regular auction sales uneven, ranging 16.00 lower to 16.00 higher. Slaughter cows mostly 2.00 to 5.00 lower. Wheat .12 higher. Corn mostly .07 lower, new crop .02 to .07 higher. Soybeans mostly steady to .07 higher, new crop .04 lower.

IN THE NATION, feeder cattle uneven in the Southeast; mostly 8.00 to 12.00 higher in the North and South Central regions. Slaughter cattle live basis mostly 6.00 to 7.00 higher at 225.00 to 244.00; dressed basis sales mostly 10.00 to 12.00 higher at 375.00 to 386.00. Slaughter cows mostly steady to 5.00 higher. Slaughter bulls mostly steady to 5.00 higher. Slaughter lambs 50-90 lbs 10.00 to 20.00 lower; 90-130 lbs 30.00 to 40.00 lower. Slaughter ewes mostly 10.00 to 15.00 lower. Feeder lambs not tested. Hogs carcass basis 5.15 higher. Wheat mostly .12 to .15 higher. Corn mostly .07 to .10 lower. Soybeans mostly steady to .10 higher. Cotton .0056 higher per pound in the Southeast.

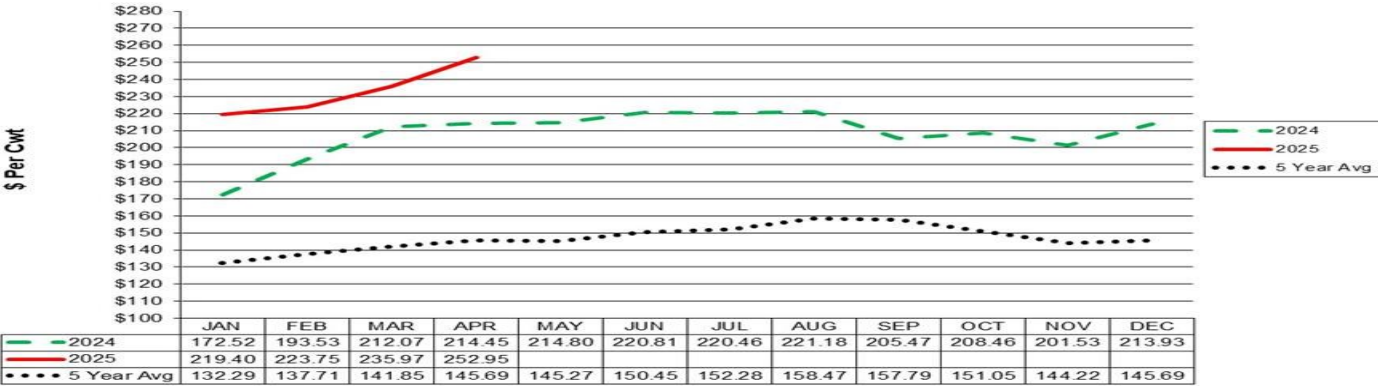
